[PROPOSED] ORDER ISSUING PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION AND ESTABLISHING BRIEFING  
AND HEARING SCHEDULE

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1 TO DEFENDANT AND RESPONDENT CAMARILLO HEALTH CARE DISTRICT, REAL  
2 PARTY IN INTEREST GOLDEN RULE PUBLISHING, INC. DBA CAMARILLO ACORN, AND  
3 THEIR ATTORNEYS OF RECORD:

4 On December 19, 2016, the Court heard argument regarding the Order to Show Cause re  
5 Issuance of Preliminary Injunction. Andrew M. Gilford, of Baute Crochetiere & Gilford LLP,  
6 appeared on behalf of Plaintiff and Petitioner Jane Rozanski ("Rozanski"). Michael A. Velthoen, of  
7 Ferguson Case Orr Paterson LLP, appeared on behalf of Defendant and Respondent Camarillo Health  
8 Care District (the "District"), and Oscar C. Gonzalez, of Benton, Orr, Duval, & Buckingham,  
9 appeared on behalf of Real Party in Interest Golden Rule Publishing, Inc. dba Camarillo Acorn (the  
10 "Acorn"). The Court, having read and considered the parties' respective briefing, and having  
11 considered oral argument at the December 19 hearing, hereby Orders as follows:

12 Rozanski has established that (i) the balance of respective harm strongly favors Rozanski; and  
13 (2) she has a reasonable likelihood of prevailing on her claim that the subject voicemails do not  
14 constitute "public records" subject to disclosure under the California Public Records Act. The Court  
15 therefore issues the requested preliminary injunction and Orders as follows:

16 PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

17 Pending the final determination, on the merits, of Rozanski's Petition for Writ of Mandate, the  
18 District, its officers, agents, employees, representatives, members, attorneys, and all persons acting on  
19 behalf of the District are enjoined from engaging in or performing any of the following acts or things:

20 a. Disclosing the voicemails, or the specific content of the voicemails (e.g., by a verbatim  
21 transcript), identified by the District as responsive to the California Public Records Act Requests made  
22 by either the Acorn or the Ventura County Star in response to such requests. Nothing in this  
23 injunction shall be read to prevent the District from describing the general nature of the voicemail  
24 messages in connection with Court proceedings;

25 b. Ordering, directing, assisting, aiding, or abetting, in any manner, any person in  
26 engaging in or attempting to engage in any of the above-mentioned activities; and

27 c. Taking any action of any nature which may be designed or intended to furnish or would  
28 have the effect of furnishing aid or assistance, financial or otherwise, to any person in the conduct or

1 continuance of the above-mentioned activities.

2 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:**

3 The hearing on Rozanski's Petition for Writ of Mandate shall be held on February 10, 2017 at  
4 10:00 a.m. in Department 20. The parties shall advise the Court by February 2, 2017, whether they  
5 intend to call live witnesses at the hearing.

6 Rozanski's Opening Brief shall be filed and served on or before January 13, 2017. The  
7 District's and the Acorn's Response Briefs shall be filed and served on or before January 25.  
8 Rozanski's Reply Brief shall be filed and served on or before February 2. Service shall be made by e-  
9 mail. The parties may have up to 25 pages for each brief.

10 This Order Issuing Preliminary Injunction and Establishing the Briefing and Hearing Schedule,  
11 shall be served by Rozanski on the District and the Acorn by e-mail within one (1) business day of  
12 Rozanski's receipt of the signed Order. Proof of such service shall be filed on or before February 10.

13 **IT IS SO ORDERED.**




