TO DEFENDANT AND RESPONDENT CAMARILLO HEALTH CARE DISTRICT, REAL PARTY IN INTEREST GOLDEN RULE PUBLISHING, INC. DBA CAMARILLO ACORN, AND THEIR ATTORNEYS OF RECORD:

On December 19, 2016, the Court heard argument regarding the Order to Show Cause re Issuance of Preliminary Injunction. Andrew M. Gilford, of Baute Crochetiere & Gilford LLP, appeared on behalf of Plaintiff and Petitioner Jane Rozanski ("Rozanski"). Michael A. Velthoen, of Ferguson Case Orr Paterson LLP, appeared on behalf of Defendant and Respondent Camarillo Health Care District (the "District"), and Oscar C. Gonzalez, of Benton, Orr, Duval, & Buckingham, appeared on behalf of Real Party in Interest Golden Rule Publishing, Inc. dba Camarillo Acorn (the "Acorn"). The Court, having read and considered the parties' respective briefing, and having considered oral argument at the December 19 hearing, hereby Orders as follows:

Rozanski has established that (i) the balance of respective harm strongly favors Rozanski; and (2) she has a reasonable likelihood of prevailing on her claim that the subject voicemails do not constitute "public records" subject to disclosure under the California Public Records Act. The Court therefore issues the requested preliminary injunction and Orders as follows:

PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

Pending the final determination, on the merits, of Rozanski's Petition for Writ of Mandate, the District, its officers, agents, employees, representatives, members, attorneys, and all persons acting on behalf of the District are enjoined from engaging in or performing any of the following acts or things:

- a. Disclosing the voicemails, or the specific content of the voicemails (e.g., by a verbatim transcript), identified by the District as responsive to the California Public Records Act Requests made by either the Acorn or the Ventura County Star in response to such requests. Nothing in this injunction shall be read to prevent the District from describing the general nature of the voicemail messages in connection with Court proceedings;
- b. Ordering, directing, assisting, aiding, or abetting, in any manner, any person in engaging in or attempting to engage in any of the above-mentioned activities; and
- c. Taking any action of any nature which may be designed or intended to furnish or would have the effect of furnishing aid or assistance, financial or otherwise, to any person in the conduct or
