Agent (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) at the San Diego Sector (b) (7)(E) said this

Caravan incident would be included in the daily Caravan (b) (7)(E) that is emailed out daily at 9 a.m. (b) (7)(E) Station Day Shift agents are being canvassed for any pertinent information they have pertaining to this incident.

On December 9, 2018, at approximately 12:40 p.m., a group of eight (8) suspected migrants from the Caravan illegally entered the United States through (b) (7)(E). All eight were determined to be natives and citizens of Honduras. Initial reports were that there was a group of 20 suspected migrants in Mexico, south of (b) (7)(E). Approximately 12 stayed behind in Mexico and did not make entry into the United States. Twin girls were part of the eight arrested. Their mother appeared to injure her ankle while climbing the border fence. She was last seen on the west side of (b) (7)(E) (b) (7)(E) south of the international boundary fence, being escorted by (b) (7)(E).

Agents who were in the area reported that members of the media were actively aiding and abetting the migrants climb the border fence at the bottom of the canyon. With the assistance of a loudspeaker, an SBPA from the (b) (7)(E) (b) (7)(E) Station advised members of the media, in both Spanish and English, not to assist or encourage the migrants to illegally enter the United States. The Acting Watch Commander approached the border fence and advised members of the media that it was a crime in the United States to aid or abet an alien to illegally enter the United States. He further stated that Border Patrol agents in the area had witnessed members of the media assisting suspected migrant caravan members climb the border fence.

Members of the media appeared to be recording the statement made by the Acting Watch Commander. An agent working at the (b) (7)(E) confirmed that (b) (7)(E) would have good footage of what transpired in (b) (7)(E) since he was able to see it from the (b) (7)(E). At the conclusion of the event, the Acting Watch Commander contacted San Diego Sector (b) (7)(E) and requested that any footage of the event be saved and burned to a disc in the event it depicts criminal

aiding and abetting by members of the media. The supervisor working at Sector dispatch stated that it was already being retrieved for such purposes.
