Counsel for the parties met and conferred on May 31, 2024 by telephone to discuss whether Defendant would consent to the filing of Plaintiff's Second Amended Complaint; after conferring with his client, Defendant's counsel on June 3, 2024 advised Plaintiff's counsel that his client did not concur.

Plaintiff therefore seeks leave of this Court to file a Second Amended
 Complaint. The proposed Second Amended Complaint is attached hereto as
 Exhibit 1.

10.Plaintiff also seeks a stay of the briefing and argument schedule in this matter.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff respectfully requests this honorable Court grant this Motion and enter the attached proposed Order granting Plaintiff leave to file the attached Second Amended Complaint and to stay the briefing and argument schedule.
